Interact with the passage and questions:

- Look at title, length of passage.
- Read questions.

Note what you know:

- Decide on type of questions and label with proper codes.
- Think about what you know about the topic. (Activate background knowledge.)

Find clues:

- Read the passage.
- Underline clues.

Explore any supporting details:

- Go back to each question and read it.
- Look back at your clues.
- Look for more clues if you need them.

Return to the question

- Answer each question
